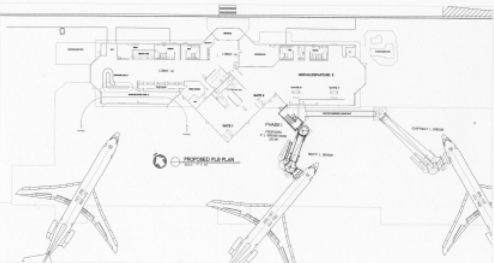


*Existing Terminal Plan*

## INTERNATIONAL ARRIVALS EXPANSION

Gary/Chicago Airport,

At Gary/Chicago Airport, I had the opportunity to work with the Airport Administrator Paul Karas and the Airport Engineer, Ken Ross to provide Terminal Planning Services for a Proposed New International Arrivals – Concourse ‘B’ Addition. The new Concourse is to be a two story structure, departing from the current one story main building. This arrangement would provide deplaning on the second floor with a smaller PLB system into a separated Immigration and Customs area. Baggage claim and support services would then be on the first floor.

The proposed 8,000 sf design would be contextual in design to the existing facility and is planned according to a \$2.7 million construction budget. This project is on hold pending Board Approval and funding.

The study also included a new configuration for Gate 2, as new security requirements resulting from 9/11 changes reduced existing holding area. Incorporated in this new Gate would be an enclosure for HC Accessible stairs and elevator, and a new PLB.
