NEW GENERAL AVIATION

TERMINAL Huntington Municipal Airport, IN

A new generation of general aviation buildings is desperately needed to replace the aging stock of these facilities in Indiana.

This newly complete terminal in 2006 has an area of 3,000 sf. It was public bid with a “tight” budget of approximately \$624,000 in the summer of ‘05. The Owner used existing and future Non-Primary Entitlement funds from the FAA

It will function as the airport command center, a public meeting space, flight training, and a general way-station for the passengers and pilots of the modern light-commercial aircraft industry.

At the time of these photographs the project was still under construction with the sitework not complete. Owner occupancy was June 2006.
